## State Sponsored Cyber-attacks on UK Infrastructure and its Suppliers.

Companies operating in and around UK critical infrastructure may be especially susceptible to cyber-attacks from foreign countries. The National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC/GCHQ) reports that these attacks predominately emanate from Russia, China, and Iran.

Due to these attacks becoming more sophisticated, CITS in association with the NCSC/GCHQ, the Metropolitan Police Cyber-Security Team, and Security Awareness Special Interest Group (SASIG) have arranged a unique security briefing for Managers and Directors of businesses operating in this sector.

The briefing will give examples of the organisations carrying out these attacks, and their methodology on how they could infiltrate and circumvent your security systems.

The speakers include:

**Mr Scott C - the Private Sector Resilience Lead from the NCSC** who will highlight the most disruptive cyber-attacks hitting UK businesses; particularly with the UK now labelled as a 'hostile' country by some foreign states.

**Mr Martin Smith, the Chair and founder of SASIG** - the UK's fastest growing cybersecurity networking group with 7000+ members representing the top UK businesses.

To end the event there will be a escape room exercise, plus the Metropolitan Police's Cyber-Security Team will reveal the secrets in quickly cracking most passwords, and how this will allow you to review and improve your own personal and your company's passwords!
