This event is for Police to Police training and briefing on detection techniques to assist forces based in the East of England area, covering Cambridgeshire, Northamptonshire, Bedfordshire, Norfolk and Suffolk. It is a free to attend event for Police officers, PCSO's and Police staff only.

The event will be hosted by the National Vehicle Crime Intelligence Service (NaVCIS) and supported by industry and held at Ben Burgess Ellington.

Attendees will be given presentations by NaVCIS and include briefings by DC Chris Piggott, UK's international police liaison officer, CESAR's police liaison team and will include expert advice on detecting criminal networks operating within your area.

The training day will also include the opportunity to examine machines demonstrating CESAR, Micro-CESAR, and OEM markings, which will allow officers to learn of high-risk items which are susceptible to theft and moreover give officers the confidence to identify stolen property easily.
