The training day will also include the opportunity to examine machines demonstrating CESAR (The Construction and Agricultural Equipment Security & Registration scheme), OEM markings and the new RAPID Online App (Registered Assets Police Information Database), which will allow officers to learn of high-risk items which are susceptible to theft and moreover give officers the confidence to identify stolen property easily.
